

Suicide Prevention Trainings by Missouri Region

This guide is intended to help connect interested stakeholders (e.g., suicide prevention coalitions, advocates, health, and behavioral providers) to identify and access a variety of suicide prevention trainings near them. Training Information is organized by region below. Designated regions and associated counties align with the <u>Community Mental Health Centers</u> service areas. Organizations providing services statewide or for most Missouri counties are also outlined.

Information is included on a variety of trainings, including:

- <u>Mental Health First Aid</u> (MHFA) and related courses: skills-based training course that teaches participants about mental health and substance-use issues. To find an MFHA-related course near you, click <u>here</u>. Virtual options may be available through some instructors. Additional courses available:
 - Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis.
 - teen Mental Health First Aid (tMHFA) is a teen training program.
 - Spanish versions are available for MHFA and the Youth MHFA trainings.
- <u>Zero Suicide</u>: a system-wide approach to improve suicide care within health and behavioral health systems. The foundational belief of Zero Suicide is that suicide deaths for individuals under the care of health and behavioral health systems are preventable. For systems dedicated to improving patient safety, Zero Suicide presents an aspirational challenge and practical framework for system-wide transformation toward safer suicide care.
- <u>Counseling (Conversations) around Lethal Means</u> (CALM): the course is about how to reduce access to the methods people use to kill themselves. It covers who needs lethal means counseling and how to work with people at risk for suicide—and their families—to reduce access.
- <u>Questions. Persuade. Refer</u>. (QPR): trains people to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help. **To find an instructor near you to train your organization, click <u>here</u>.**
- <u>Missouri Ask Listen Refer</u> (ALR): designed to help Missouri residents prevent suicide by teaching them to identify people at risk, recognize the risk and protective factors, and respond to and get help for people at risk. **This free training can be completed** <u>online</u>.



- <u>Signs of Suicide</u> (SOS): teaches students how to identify indicators of depression and suicide in themselves and their peers.
- <u>Collaborative Assessment and Management of Suicidality (CAMS)-Care</u>: trains clinicians and systems of care to treat people suffering from thoughts of suicide. **Online training courses for individuals or multiple organization seats can be purchased** <u>here</u>.
- <u>LivingWorks Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training</u> (ASIST): teaches participants to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and work with them to create a plan that will support their immediate safety. **To find a training near you, click <u>here</u>**.
- <u>Veteran Affairs S.A.V.E</u> (Signs, Ask, Validate, Encourage and Expedite): training to help those who encounter a Veteran in crisis.
